

Chatham County WWI Who Served?

On 6 April 1917, the United States declared war on Germany and officially entered World War I. Six weeks later, on 18 May 1917, the Selective Service Act was passed, authorizing the president to increase the military establishment of the United States. As a result, adult males living in the US were required to register for the draft.

Three registrations for the draft were held: on 5 June 1917, 5 June 1918, and 24 August 1918. See more about the [WWI Draft in Chatham](#) and the information available from draft cards in our article on that topic.

It is important to note that not all men who registered for the draft served in the military. And not all of those who served registered for the draft.

After Registration – Lotteries

When men registered for the draft, they were assigned a lottery number. After each draft registration, lotteries were held to determine who would be drafted. The first lottery was conducted on 20 July 1917. The front page of the 25 July 1917 *Chatham Record* described the drawing and listed several thousand numbers, given in the order drawn, and from which those who would be called to serve first in the Army would be selected.

AVIATION SERVICE MEASURE ADOPTED

THE SENATE PASSES HOUSE BILL
WITHOUT AMENDMENT ON
RECORD VOTE.

640,000,000 APPROPRIATED

Only Dispute in Upper House Was
Over Amendment to Strike out
Draft Class—Provides for About
22,000 Airplanes.

Washington.—The House bill appropriating \$400,000,000 for the aviation service was passed by the Senate without amendment or a record vote discussion. It now goes to the President.
The Senate's only dispute, with many members expressing a desire to pass the bill immediately, was over an amendment by Senator Hardwick, of Georgia, to strike out a clause authorizing the drafting of the men for the aerial service. The amendment was rejected sixty-seven to twelve after Senators LaFollette and Cronin made brief speeches opposing the draft.

Order for Liability for Service Established by Historic Lottery.

258 FIRST NUMBER OUT

Secretary Baker Takes Out Initial Number—Drawing Continues All Day Friday and Throughout Night.

Long List of Numbers Given in Order as Drawn, From Which Those Who Will Be Called to Serve in First Army Will Be Selected.

Washington, July 21.—The drawing for the big United States army was not completed until early Saturday morning. The drawing began at 9:45 Friday morning, and continued throughout the day and night. Altogether 10,500 numbers were drawn from the big fish bowl. It was officially stated that the first 1,000 numbers drawn represented more than 1,000,000 men, and it is not considered probable that men representing any number drawn after the first 2,000 will be called before any exemption board for the first army. The first eight numbers were drawn respectively by Secretary of War Baker, Senator Chamberlain of the senate military committee, Congressman Dent of the house military committee, Senator Warren and Representative Kahn, ranking minority members of the senate and house military committees; Maj. Gen. Tasker H. Bliss, acting chief of staff of the army; Maj. Gen. Enoch Crowder, provost marshal of the army; and Major General McCain, adjutant general of the army. After the first eight numbers had been drawn the regular tellers took hold, and worked through until the long task was completed.

In only a small number of the largest districts will the numbers above a few thousand affect registrants. Of the 4,557 registration districts throughout the country the largest has something over 10,200 numbers, while the smallest has only about 185, and the average is about 3,000. As the drawing proceeded, 157 numbers were withdrawn before one low enough to affect the smallest district came out. It was 126, placing 4,557 men numbered 126 on their local lists as 157th in order of liability.

The following list shows the numbers in the order in which they were drawn. The first number in each case represents the order in which the second, or red-ink registry, number was taken from the bowl. Four numbers are given in each line. Beginning with the first number, which was drawn by Secretary Baker.

As the article notes, the first number drawn was 258. In Chatham, 258 was the number assigned to Lester H. Hilliard, of Bear Creek.

His name, along with more than 400 others whose numbers were drawn from Chatham registrants, was listed on page two of the same issue of the *Record*.

On last Friday the War Department at Washington drew by lot the names of those who will be liable in the order named to military duty. A second list was printed on 1 August 1917 in the Chatham Record with the following notice.

ADDITIONAL NAMES DRAWN

We published last week 475 names of persons in Chatham county who were among the first drawn in the recent drawing at Washington of those liable for military service, in the order in which they were drawn. We are now publishing some more of the names in the order in which they were drawn, following the list of last issue.

As 192 is the net number of soldiers to be drafted from this county, and as no one knows how many of those drawn will be exempted, it may require the examination of several hundred before the 192 are secured.

If the required number of 192 is not secured out of those first summoned for examination, then others will be summoned, in the order in which they were drawn, until the full quota of 192 is obtained.

Grounds for Exemption.

From News and Observer.

Here are the grounds for exemption and discharge, application for which must be made on proper forms to be furnished by the board upon the posting of the person drafted:

That you are an officer, legislative, executive or judicial of the United States, a state or territory or the District of Columbia.

That you are a regular or duly ordained minister of religion.

That you were on May 18, 1917, a student preparing for the ministry in any recognized theological or divinity school.

That you are in the military or naval service of the United States.

In addition to claims for exemption claims for discharge may be made on any of the following grounds, which are the only grounds for discharge by a local board:

That you are a county or municipal officer.

That you are employed by the United States in the transmission of mails.

That you are an artificer or workman employed in an armory, arsenal or navy yard of the United States.

That you are employed in the service of the United States (under certain conditions.)

That you are a licensed pilot, regularly employed in the pursuit of your vocation.

That you are a mariner, actually employed in the sea service of any citizen or merchant within the United States.

That you are a married man with a wife or child dependent on you for support.

That you have a widowed mother dependent on your labor for support.

That you have aged or infirm parents dependent on your labor for support.

That you are the father of a motherless child under 16, dependent upon your labor for support.

That you are a brother of an orphan child or children under 16, dependent on your labor for support.

That you are a member of any well recognized religious sect or organization organized and existent on May 18, 1917, and whose then existing creed or principles forbade its members to participate in war in any form and whose religious convictions are against war or participation therein in accordance with the creed or principles of said religious organization.

These are the only grounds for exemption or discharge by a local board.

Another person can file a claim in your behalf, but must use different form in filing the claim.

During the seven days the person claiming exemption must file affidavit of his claim, supported by the affidavits of a disinterested person acquainted with the facts. The exemption board will hear no oral claim nor argument. The person claiming exemption and denied it may appeal to a district board and from that board to the president. The exemption board must pass upon affidavits within two days after they have been filed. Claim for exemption on industrial grounds must be made with affidavits and by form to the district board on or before the fifth day following posting of the person as drafted.

Exemptions

Even if a man's number was drawn and he was required to report, he may not have been called to serve. Many men were exempt from the draft based on criteria such as their medical fitness, the needs for manpower in certain industries and in agriculture, and special family circumstances and dependents.

On 1 Aug 1917, the *Chatham Record* reprinted an article from the *Raleigh News and Observer* that listed the grounds for exemption that registrants might apply for if their number was drawn and they were called to report. [Reproduced at left.]

So, even though Lester H. Hilliard of Bear Creek was first in line among Chatham men to be inducted, he may not have served. His registration card indicated that he was married and supported his mother, wife and two children. If the local draft board accepted this claim, he would have been exempted or discharged by the local board, and Fred Taylor of Corinth, with number 458, would have been next in line for service.


We'll use Lester and Fred in some examples below.

Records of Those Who Served

Since many men who registered for the draft and even many of those whose numbers were drawn did not serve in the military, what records can tell us who *did* serve?

Service cards

WWI Service Cards were created after the war and include information such as rank, unit, overseas service dates and dates of discharge from active military service, in addition to place and date of induction, residence, and place and date of birth for officers, enlisted men, nurses, medics and chaplains who served in an official military capacity during World War I.

No service card was found for Lester H. Hilliard of Chatham who likely was exempt from service.

Originals of the service cards of North Carolina residents are maintained at the State Archives of North Carolina. A searchable online database has been created that is searchable by name. Branches of service include the Army, Navy, Marine Corps and Coast Guard. The actual service card is viewable through the database.

Note that you might need to search counties other than Chatham to find your relative, if they didn't register in Chatham. Many people, especially young adults were moving to less rural areas to find work during the early 1900s, so those who were raised in Chatham may have been in places like Durham or Raleigh or elsewhere when the US entered the war.

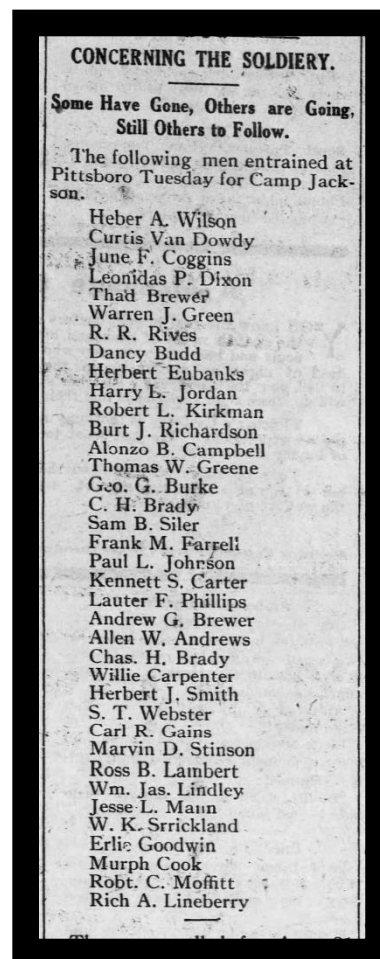
